**BREAD FOR THE WORLD OFFERING OF LETTERS TODAY!** The Service and Mission Committee invites you to sign the Bread for the World letters to your two Senators and one Congressional representative today. Letter writing materials, tables and chairs are set up in the narthex. Churches across America participate in the **Offering of Letters** because we believe that God calls us to live and work on behalf of the vulnerable among us—and with each other. Take this opportunity to sign a pre-written letter or construct your own message asking Congress to make permanent our current tax benefits for low-income families, parts of which will expire this year if Congress fails to act. The Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and Child Tax Credit reward the efforts of low-income working families—especially those who are working full-time at the minimum wage.
